PreK-4, Preschool, and all of our other classes will start on Monday, August 17. Our teachers are excited and are looking forward to having your children in their classes. You can drop off your child's supplies on that day, with your child. Don't forget to label all supplies, including the extra clothes.

Book Fees (Curriculum Fees) are due Monday, August 10 and will be charged to your account then. The price is **\$55.00** for Preschool books and **\$80.00** for PreK-4 books.

The Annual Registration Fee of \$125.00 will be charged to your account on Tuesday, September 8. Some of you, newly-enrolled, might have already paid this fee and will not be charged. Also, those who may have entered into our center after last September, your charges **will** be pro-rated.


Open House 2015- 2016

An Important Reminder:

The safety of the children in our care is very important to us. Please review and make sure to follow these policies.

- All children must be checked in at the front desk before proceeding to class.
- Children must be checked in by 9:00 AM, and if not, a doctor's excuse is needed.
- Check-in tickets must be given to the child's teacher when the child is **brought in** to the teacher and when the child is **picked up** from the teacher.
- All children must be checked out at the front desk before the parent proceeds to class to pick up the child.
- All adults checking out children must set up their own computer codes. These codes should **never** be shared. These codes enable CELC to keep an accurate account of check-ins & check-outs, as required by the Department of Education.
- All children should be escorted to class.
- All children should be escorted while in the parking lot. No child should ever be allowed to walk across the parking lot unescorted.
- Children must be checked out and picked up from the classroom by an authorized adult (at least 16 years of age).
