School's out for Summer!! The days are longer, temps are hotter, our summer camp has kicked off, and it's time for some fun in the sun!!

Parents...please remember, all children must be checked into the center by 9:00AM. There will be no exceptions and you will not be allowed to check your child in without a doctor's excuse. Even with a doctor's excuse, no children are allowed in past 10:45. For Summer Camp children, on field trip days, we leave the center at 9:00 and your child should be checked into the center by 8:30, at the very latest. If your child misses the field trip bus, your child cannot be left at the center. There will be no refunds given.

Per our dress code, all children must wear closed-toe shoes (sneakers). There will be no open-toe sandals, flip flops, boots, Crocs, etc. If these are worn, you will be called to bring the appropriate shoes to the center. Also, please send extra clothing (labeled with your child's name) in a Ziploc bag, in case of bathroom accidents.

Some classes have been given summer supply lists. If you have not turned your child's supplies in yet, please do so.

Fees for the next school year...

Curriculum fees for the 24-25 Three and Four year old classes are due now. For children who will be in Preschool classes (3 year olds), the book fee is \$75.00. For children who will be in the PreK-4 classes (4 year olds), the book fee is \$110.00. Please see Ms Lori to pay or to have this fee deducted from your Tuition Express.

Annual Registrations will be assessed the first of August. These will be due then and can be paid via Tuition Express or by check or cash. If you have any questions, please see the front office. The registration fee is \$175.00.







































Bugs, Bugs, Bugs!

Although we have EBR Mosquito Abatement come out and spray on our outside premises, and a monthly pest control taking care of the inside, it seems there are lots of bugs enjoying this warm weather. If you would like to send bug spray, feel free to do so. Please make sure that the container is labeled with your child's name. Also, you will need to fill out a Topical Ointment form. Bug spray must be DEET-free.

Summer Pool Rules:

These rules are in place to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all campers. If at any time, a camper breaks these rules, it will result in loss of swim time, write up, and/or a suspension.

- 1. No diving into the pool. When jumping into the pool, only jump in from the deep end, one at a time, & wait for the previous camper to move out of the way.
- 2. No horseplay! (no running around the pool, no splashing others, do not hang onto others, do not continuously get in & out of the pool)
- 3. When entering the pool area, sit on the side of the pool & wait for the lifeguard to tell you to get in.
- **4.** No swimming past 4 ft. unless you have passed the swim test.
- 5. When the whistle is blown, all campers must stop, swim to the side of the pool, & wait for further instructions from the lifeguard.
- 6. Only one-piece, or tankinis with long tops, may be worn by female campers.

Summer Recipe:

Frito Corn Salad

Ingredients

- 2 (15 ounce) cans whole kernel corn, drained
- 2 cups grated cheddar cheese
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1 cup green pepper, chopped
- 1/2 cup red onion, diced finely
- 1 (10 1/2 ounce) bag coarsely crushed regular Fritos corn chips or Fritos chili cheese corn chips
- Fritos Scoops for serving

Instructions

1. Mix first 5 ingredients and chill. Stir in corn chips just before serving. You may not want to add all of the corn chips. Add a little at a time. Some people prefer to just serve the Fritos on the side or crumbled on top. You can eat this with a spoon or as a dip with Fritos Scoops for serving.
